HOW TO NOMINATE

Participants are invited to nominate a special woman by submitting an essay (of no more than 500 words) on or before February 13, 2008. Also, submit an electronic photograph of the nominee.

Include

the following in your essay:

- A brief background on nominee
- Overview of how she has had an impact on your life or others
- Any life lessons you learn from nominee
- How she is leading and shaping the future

THE PROCESS

A panel of judges will review the entries and a finalist will be announced at the annual event on March 14, 2008.
